**ANIMAL FEEDING** – A reminder not to feed the animals outside or fines will be assessed up to \$150.00 per occurrence. PLEASE DO NOT FEED ANY GEESE OR DUCKS. THIS FINE WILL BE ENFORCED.

**SCREEN DOORS** – \*\*\* WE WILL BE REPAIRING ALL SCREEN DOORS WEATHER PENDING THE NEXT TWO WEEKS.\*\*Screen doors will be repaired on as needed basis. We realize the screens are older and we have made efforts to repair them as they break. However, there have been many instances of tenants, guests etc., walking through or damaging these screens. Therefore, starting this year, if a screen appears to be damaged by the tenant, there will be a \$50.00 repair fee assessed for damage of this nature. These screens brand new are over \$135.00 to replace them. Please understand, we can tell when the screens just “fell off the track” and when they have been damaged by someone walking through it. We get calls saying they just fell off all the time and when we get there, the screen mesh is damaged or the frame is bent. Erv has been repairing these for 28 years. So please watch when your screen is closed.

**PET WASTE & LEASHING** – Now that the weather is breaking, please clean up all pet waste in the front and back areas. Please be advised if this is not done in a timely manner, warnings will be given and then fines will be issues. Please keep your pets on leashes at all times. This is our policy and also a City of Medina Ordinance too.

**GUTTERS**- We will be starting to repair the gutters throughout the complex this spring. Our hope is to stop the leaking and over flow of the gutters.

**CARPORIT/FRONT PORCH AREA SPRING CLEANING**- Please make sure your carport is cleaned up and in orderly fashion. Please clean up winter trash and place cabinets or shelving where needed to organize your area. Please make sure your patio area is cleaned up too and front porch patio furniture does not extend further out than the black iron railings so EMS can get by if needed. We appreciate your cooperation.

**NEW SIDING & GRILLS**- With the warmer weather coming, we know you will want to grill out. We currently do allow grills on the back porch. We would like to caution you to be careful when grilling out. Please make sure that your grill is not operated under the carport and is placed on the outside edge of your back patio away from the back door. You may also place it in the drive just in front of your

carport. We caution you of this use because the heat from the grill can and will melt the siding and or cause a fire.
